#### What is Child Protection about?

- All the adults in school want to make sure that you are happy and safe in school and at home
- We can help make sure that your rights are respected by everyone in your life
- Making sure nothing stops you from being healthy and learning in school
- Giving you the best chance to be successful and achieve in life

#### What can we do for you?

- We will provide you with a warm, welcoming environment to learn in
- We can help you stay safe inside and outside school and are always here to talk to you when you don't feel safe or are worried about anything
- At school you will learn how to keep yourself safe inside and outside of school as well as online
- We will help you learn and grow as a young person to help you succeed in life
- Make sure everyone in your life treats you fairly and with respect

#### When should you ask to talk to someone?

- If you're unhappy or worried about something
- If somebody has hurt you or you've seen somebody get hurt
- If someone says something or does something that makes you feel uncomfortable, frightened or upset
- If someone isn't taking care of your properly or respecting your wishes
- If someone touches you in a way you don't like or asks you to take your clothes off making you feel uncomfortable – remember the PANTS rule from Pantosaurus

## If you're unhappy or worried about something, the best thing you can do is talk to an adult

#### Who can you talk to?

You can talk to anyone in school. We are all here to help you with anything you need!

Your teacher might be a good person to talk to or any adult from your class. You can even ask to speak to Mr Mack or Mrs Woodward if you're worried about something.
