Arbour App

We are now only using Arbor within school and are asking all parents to download the Arbor app to access important information about School. If school don't have your email address, please could you contact us, and we can send out an email with a link to sign up. Look out for dinner money payments on Arbor as this is now up and running.





On Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October we will be changing our telephone provider, this means we will be having a change in number. ### **Reporting absences**

Please note this message will come directly to us so we will not message back to say we have received this.
