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KEY STAGE ONE PHONICS

KEY STAGE ONE PHONICS YEAR 1	69% of pupils achieved the expected standard which is below the national average of 82%.
KEY STAGE ONE PHONICS RECHECK YEAR 2	11 pupils retook the phonics screening test. 7 of the 11 pupils achieved the expected standard (64%).

KEY STAGE ONE ASSESSMENT RESULTS

KEY STAGE ONE READING	69% of pupils achieved the expected standard or above which is 6% below the national average . 9% attained greater depth which is 17% below the national average .
KEY STAGE ONE WRITING	66% of pupils achieved the expected standard or above which is 4% below the national average . 9% attained greater depth which is 7% below the national average .
KEY STAGE ONE MATHS	71% of pupils achieved the expected standard or above which is 5% below the national average . 9% attained greater depth which is 13% below the national average .
KEY STAGE ONE RWM COMBINED	63% of pupils achieved the expected standard, which is 2% below the national average .
