World Book Day



To celebrate **World Book Day**, we will be doing something a little different this year! Although World Book Day officially takes place on **Thursday 5th March**, we will be celebrating in school on **Friday 6th March**.

For the day, we're doing something a little different and fun – we are asking the children to come dressed as a **word**! Choose an interesting word, learn what it means, and create a costume that represents it. This is a great way to build vocabulary and be creative at the same time.

We encourage children to choose an interesting word – ideally one they haven't used before in their writing or a new one they have come across in their reading book. This is a fantastic opportunity to expand vocabulary and get creative! Costumes do not need to be elaborate or expensive – simple ideas are often the most effective. For example:

- Dressing as a footballer for the word athletic
- Wearing sparkly clothes for the word shimmering
- Bringing a book and glasses for the word studious
