## Gentle Reminder of Reporting Absences

Please can parents and carers let the school office know as soon as possible if their child is going to be absent, and before 9:00am on the first day of absence, so that we can authorise the absence correctly.

If your child needs to leave school early for an appointment, please show the office an appointment card, letter, or text message when collecting them.

As outlined in Department for Education guidance, children whose attendance falls below 90% are classed as *persistently absent*. For these children, medical evidence will be required for illness-related absences in order for the school to authorise them. Medical evidence will also be required for any illness absence lasting more than 3 consecutive days.
